
2020 PIT COUNT MAIN POINTS

- Methodology: Unsheltered were surveyed and observed 1 day on January 23, 2020. Observations were based on HUD tool that collects important demographic information for those who refuse or cannot be surveyed by volunteers. Survey was administered by a mobile app this year. Shelter data was pulled from HMIS.
- Overall, the total homeless population in the Point In Time Count has not changed drastically over the past two years. After rising steadily from 2011 2015, the PIT Count total has decreased by 10% since its peak in 2017.
- Native Hawaiian and Pacific Islanders (NHPI) (31%) and Multiracial individuals (25%) made up the largest percentages of the PIT Count population.
- 82% of Multiracial individuals indicated having NHPI racial background. **51% of the overall PIT Count identified NHPI** as either their only race or part of their multiracial background.
 - NHPIs were over-represented by 210%
